Kellie Sparks introduced Mrs. Jean Sparks, who in turn introduced the speaker, Dr. John Deaton. He gave a very informative and interesting talk on his experience in the Utah desert for a Mars project. He spent two weeks as part of a team in a capsule in 2011, designed to imitate life on Mars. Dr. Deaton studied human factor engineering, an important part of space travel and habitation. His experiences made for a very interesting presentation. Janice presented Dr. Deaton with a \$30 gift certificate to Barnes and Noble after his talk.

Afterwards, the group was invited downstairs to tour the rocket model area, and see the School of Aeronautics timeline. Also they were encouraged by Kathy Turner to try out the flying simulator.
